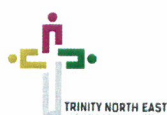

This is likely to be your final grade, and your final grade cannot be lower than this. Next week, school will receive your *moderated grades*. If the *moderated grade* is higher than the grade you receive tomorrow, then the higher grade will count.

BTEC students will receive results based on a combination of centre assessment and awarding body moderation.

We hope that you are pleased with the results you will receive tomorrow. We hope to welcome as many of you as possible back to the Sixth Form at St Robert's. However, whatever your plans, we wish you all the very best for the next stage of your education, and hope that you feel rightly proud of all that you have achieved during your time with us.
