<b>Number of Examination Papers:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 3 Papers (70% of total mark) plus practical assessment of 1 activity (30% of total mark).</li></ul>
<b>Structure of Examination Papers:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Paper 1-Exercise Physiology &amp; Biomechanics (2 hours-30% of total mark).</li><li>• Paper 2-Sports Psychology (1 hour-20% of total mark).</li><li>• Paper 3-Socio &amp; Cultural Issues (1 hour-20% of total mark).</li></ul>
<b>Key Information:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The A level PE course is a two year, linear curriculum.</li><li>• The qualification is also assessed practically</li><li>• Each paper has a combination of short answer questions about key content and finish with a long answer essay question at the end.</li><li>• Pupils need to also provide practical performance evidence in their chosen activity by the end of the Spring Term.</li></ul>
