However I would like to start by congratulating Year 11 students on how sensibly and quickly they have adapted to the new routines and systems we have in school.

The Year 11 Mock examinations will take place the week commencing the 11th January until the 22nd January. The timetable for these mock examinations can be found on our website <u>here</u>. The Mock examinations are important for a number of reasons. They will allow students to start to revise thoroughly, get experience of examination conditions and practice exam techniques. In addition it will give teachers and students a very strong indication of their current progress and attainment.

It is vital students prepare thoroughly for these Mock examinations. In school students have been participating in weekly "Ready to Revise" sessions in their Tutorial lessons. These will continue up to and after the Mock examinations. Students have been given revision starter packs and a subject by subject revision guide.
