Throughout the next six weeks, all of our pupils across Year 7-13 are encouraged to participate in CAFOD's 'Walk for Water' Lenten campaign. As a Catholic community we make it our priority to ensure that pupils have an understanding and awareness of those throughout the world who may not enjoy the same privileges and opportunities as we do.

CAFOD, a charity dedicated to the dignity and value of human life, have challenged Catholic communities throughout the country to become involved in their campaign by trying to walk 10,000 steps per day for 40 days.
