## Year 13 Study Leave and Results Day

Study leave starts for Year 13 students at the end of Friday 26<sup>th</sup> May. After this date, students need only attend college for their exams and subject booster sessions. It is important that students attend all lessons between now and the beginning of study leave.

There are some exams for Year 13 students in the two weeks prior to the half term break. Study leave is available in the morning for any afternoon exam. However, students must attend any morning lesson for their afternoon exam subject.

Results Day is Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> August. Results will be available for students to collect from 8.30am. College will not be open before 8.30am for students.

For students applying to university, their UCAS Track system will also update at 8.30am. This will inform them if they have been successful in obtaining a place on the course they intended as their Firm choice. If a student does not achieve the required grades or UCAS points for their Firm choice, they will automatically drop to their Insurance choice provided they have the required grades or UCAS points.

If a student has not gained the required grades or UCAS points for their Firm choice and Insurance choice, they will be put into Clearing. Students will then be able to apply for available courses based on their results. The list of courses available in Clearing can be viewed on the UCAS website (<a href="www.ucas.com">www.ucas.com</a>) from July 5<sup>th</sup>. Sixth Form staff will be available in college on Results day to provide advice and guidance for any student following their results.

For students not applying to university, Mrs Green will be available on Results Day between 8.30am and 12pm to provide careers information, advice and guidance.



















Students should return their subject textbooks on Results Day if they have not done so already.

Students that are not available on Results Day can request their results via email by contacting the exam office. These will be sent out once the on-site results have been distributed. Results can also be collected on behalf of students if the college has been informed of the identity of the person collecting results in advance. The person collecting results of behalf of a student will need to bring a form of photo id to be able to do so. Any uncollected results will be posted to students the day after Results day.
