### MISSION

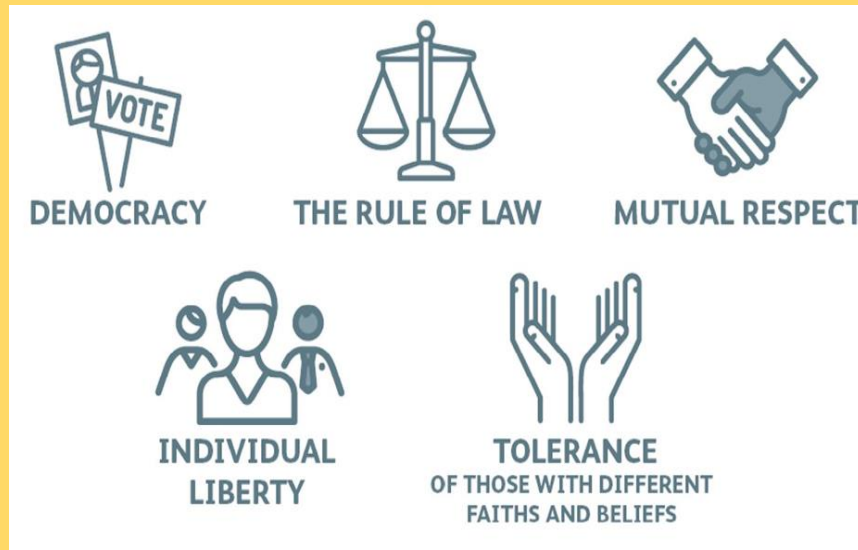
Think about your own principles and values. What do you believe to be right and good? Look at the different groups that represent our **democracy** in the UK and consider who you think is best suited for leadership.
