


# Key information

We should now have the following items for each students:

- Your child's valid passport
- Your child's valid Global Health Insurance Card (GHIC)
- **Please note: Students will not be allowed to travel without their own valid GHIC.**

Students must bring

- Spending money (approx. €100 euros).
- Sterling for the UK airport.
- Medication in a clear plastic tub clearly labelled with student details. School medication form must be completed with instructions and dosage. This is for all prescribed and non-prescribed medication (to be given to Mrs Hurst before departure).


