GCSE RESULTS DAY AND SIXTH FORM ENROLMENT

Results will be available for students to collect from 8.30am on Thursday 24th August. School will not be open before 8.30am for students.

Following collection of their results students can enrol for Sixth Form. Sixth Form staff will be available to discuss students' results, course choices and complete the enrolment process. Students will be given details of Bridging Work tasks that they should complete by the time that they enrol. The Bridging Work tasks will help students prepare for their Sixth Form courses. Sixth Form staff will be available to enrol students on Thursday 24th and Friday 25th August between 9am and 3pm.

Uniform will be available to purchase on both days. Uniform can be pre-ordered using the order form in the Sixth Form section of the school website at www.strobertofnewminster.co.uk/sixth-form/uniform/ and collected on Results Day. Uniform can be paid for using ParentPay. Students should return any subject textbooks on Results Day if they have not already done so.

Students who are not available on Results Day can request their results to be sent via email by contacting the exam office (school@str.bwcet.com for the Attention of Exams Office). If students wish their exam results to be sent to an account other than their school account, they must state this clearly in their request to the exam office. These will be sent out once the on-site results have been distributed. Results can also be collected on behalf of students if the school has been informed of the identity of the person collecting results in advance. The person collecting results of behalf of a student will need to bring a form of photo id to be able to do so. Any uncollected results will be posted to students the day after Results day.

Students who are not available on Results Day can enrol for their Sixth Form courses by emailing their results and course choices to the Sixth Form at sixthform@str.bwcet.com. Students will receive confirmation of their enrolment.
