Work for Year 7-10 Students:

Year 7-9 students have been set work that is based around our Knowledge Organisers. The work for **Year 10 students** will be focused on using GCSE Pod. All work is available on the home page of our school website under the tile "**Student Work for Wednesday 5th and Friday 7th July**".

The work set will help students revisit previous knowledge and prepare them for future work in school. All students should aim to follow their normal timetable for the day as best they can.
