All students have been emailed a link to a **revision folder** containing the following information. Students have been reminded about this throughout the year.

- A folder containing **Subject by Subject GCSE Information.** This includes information about the format of the examination and links to exams boards to access past papers and materials.
- > Students have been taught how to revise for their examinations through our "Ready to Revise Programme" in Year 10 and Year 11. Should students need to remind themselves of the various revision strategies, the lessons can be downloaded and viewed in their revision folder.
- > Students have been given copies of our bitesize "Effective Study Habits" guide. This will be useful for both parents and students and can be found in the pupil planner and in their revision folder.
